Leave St. Asaph, Denbighshire by coach at 6.00 a.m. Tuesday morning, April 3rd (picking up points to be arranged later). Arrive at Holyhead for the 8:55 a.m ferry to Dublin. Arrive 1 p.m approx, then travel to Letterkenny and arrive by 5 p.m. Stay for 5 nights. It will be possible to tour on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, should you wish. The Festival Ticket will give you free entry to all the events of the Festival mostly in the Mount Errigal Hotel.

Leave at 10 a.m Sunday, April 3rd, with the ship sailing at 3:10 p.m; arrive in Holyhead at 7:00 p.m and return to St. Asaph.(This could change)
